

RULES

Gaeilge/Irish:

Ós rud é gur Coláiste lán Ghaelach í Coláiste Chiaráin, is é an rial mór sa Choláiste ná **go gcaithfear Gaeilge a chleachtadh ar gach ócáid.**

Students who speak one complete sentence in the English language under any circumstances, for whatever reason, must leave the Coláiste.

This rule is implemented fairly and firmly and without exceptions. The decision of the Príomhoide is final in all cases of expulsion and no claims whatsoever there against will be entertained. (Fees will not be refunded)

- Pupils are forbidden to smoke, buy alcohol or consume alcohol or drugs while attending course.
- Misbehaviour of any sort is forbidden. Bullying will be punished by immediate expulsion.

Failure to comply with the rules will warrant expulsion and no reimbursement of fees is permitted.

AN COLÁISTE

1. LOCATION

The College is situated in the heart of the Gaeltacht about 25 miles from Galway City in the village of Carraroe. It can boast of many attractions, including its beaches. All of these beaches are safe.

2. ACTIVITIES
